- Administer TB tests.
- Assist doctor as needed.
- Handle emergencies as they arise
- Fill out medical forms for subjects leaving the facility
- Update medical files
- Sick Call for inmates
- Distribute Meds
- Pass Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Detention Officer Certification
- Order Medications
- Review Lab Reports

## **Minimum Qualifications (Knowledge, Skills and Abilities)**

- One(1) year full time under current LVN license
- Possess a Valid Texas Drivers License
- Must Be able to carry out Written and Oral communication
- Able to exercise judgment in application of nursing care
- Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- Bilingual (Spanish/English) abilities are an asset
